


Children in Region 1 at Risk for Type 2 Diabetes

ACANTHOSIS SCREENINGS IN TEXAS EDUCATION AGENCY-REGION 1




The AN risk factor percentage among children has decreased by 1% since the 2018-2019 school year.




(AN) is a skin condition that signals high insulin levels and high risk of developing Type 2 Diabetes.

*The Rio Grande Valley is part of Texas Education Agency Region 1.




Children living in Region 1 have a higher chance of developing type 2 diabetes.



ACANTHOSIS AND OTHER HEALTH RISKS

Children who are identified with the AN marker are also assessed for body mass index (BMI) and blood pressure.
