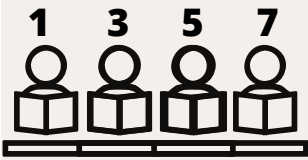




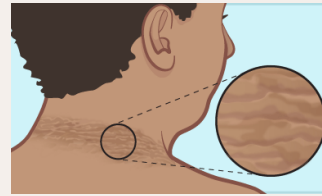

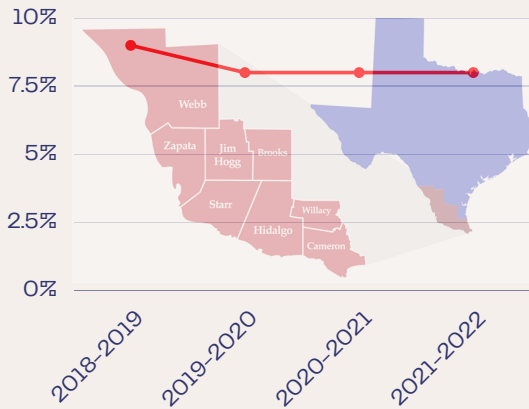


Texas children enrolled in 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th grades are assessed for the Acanthosis Nigrans marker (AN).



(AN) is a skin condition that signals high insulin levels and high risk of developing Type 2 Diabetes.

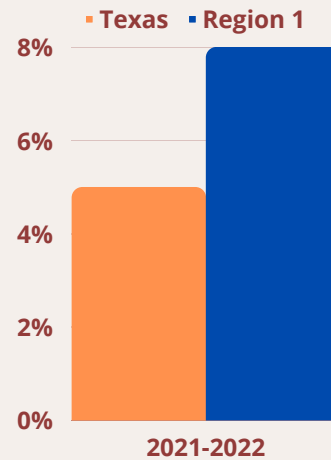
ACANTHOSIS SCREENINGS IN TEXAS EDUCATION AGENCY-REGION 1



The AN risk factor percentage among children has decreased by 1% since the 2018-2019 school year.

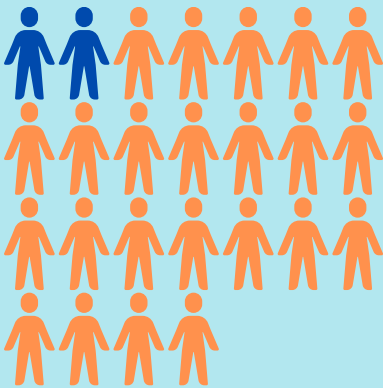
CHILDREN WITH (AN): REGION 1 VS STATE

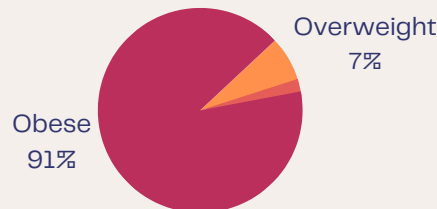

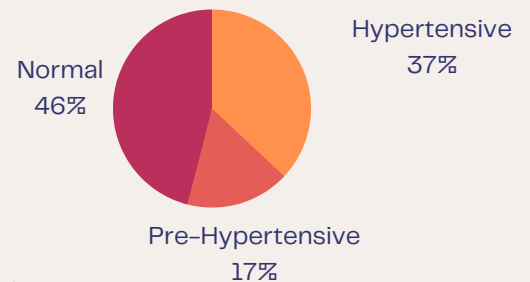
Children who are identified with the AN marker are also assessed for body mass index (BMI) and blood pressure.
